Dear Parents/carers,

Following the parent/carer Consultations, we have summarised the results from the questionnaires below. In response to the previous consultation meeting, we have included a booklet to outline how we use the Dojo behaviour reward system in school. Overleaf is a list of future workshops.

Question	What you said		What we did
Is your child happy at school?	Yes - 98%	No - 2% (4)	We are glad that so many of our children are happy at St Basil's. We have worked with, and will continue to work with, the four parents/carers who said that their child was not happy at school.
Do you feel that your child is making good progress?	Yes – 100%	No – 0%	We are delighted that all our parents/carers feel that their child is making good progress from their starting points. All members of the school community are all working together to ensure that each child reaches their full potential.
Do you feel your child receives an appropriate amount of homework for their age?	Yes – 86%	No – 14% (8)	We are very grateful that we have supportive parents/carers who complete homework tasks to help move their child's learning forwards. This year, we have supported staff in one year group to ensure that suitable homework is being sent every week. We hope this is now resolved.
Have you had any concerns?	Yes – 14%	No-86% (194)	We always endeavour to deal with any concerns and we are disappointed that one of our parents disagrees with this. If parents/carers have any concerns, we ask that they speak to us so that we can resolve any issues.
If so, do you feel that those concerns were dealt with effectively?	97%	No – 3% (1)
