Yearly forecast and half term curriculum information is also available to view within the class pages on our school website.
Do you feel that your child has had the opportunity to engage in a variety of activities and visits across the curriculum	Yes – 100%	No-0%	We are delighted that all parents and carers have recognised that we have provided a wide range of opportunities, either by taking the children on trips or bringing visitors into the school, to enhance the curriculum. This will continue throughout the school year.
Do you feel that your child has engaged in wider school activities?	Yes - 90%	No – 10% (19)	As a school we aim to provide a wide variety of after school clubs, of which the vast majority are free of charge. All teachers and teaching assistants give up their own free time to enable us to do this. As many of the clubs are popular and places are limited, due to health and safety, we try to ensure that all children have the opportunity throughout the year to participate in as many of their chosen clubs as possible. This year we have also added some extra sports clubs in the morning, before school, to further widen the variety of sports clubs offered.
