# ONLINE CONTENT 10 tips to keep your children safe online 

The internet has transformed the ability to access content. Many apps that children use are dependent on user-generated content which can encourage freedom of expression, imagination and creativity. However due to the sheer volume uploaded every day, it can be difficult for platforms to regulate and moderate everything, which means that disturbing or distressing images, videos or audio dips can slip through the net. That's why we've created this guide to provide parents and carers with some useful tips on kesping children safe online.


MONITOR VIEWING HABITS
Whilst most apps have moderation tools, inappropriate content can still slip through the net.


Make sure they are old enough to use theapp and meet the recommended age-timit



CHANGE PRIVACY SETTINGS
Make accounts private and set content filters and parental controls where possible.


## ENCOURAGE CRITICAL THINKING

Talk about what people might post online and why some posts could cause distress.
