Other ways to SAVE



Our top tips for saving energy whilst doing your laundry

- · Don't do things by half and try waiting until you have enough for a full and bigger load.
- Stay cool and wash at 30 degrees or below this uses 57% less electricity than higher temperatures.



- Be eco-friendly and use the eco-wash setting on your washing machine if you have one using this can save water and energy.
- One less wash a week could save you £8 on your annual energy bill.
- Washing during off-peak times can reduce the cost of your wash. Switching the machine on after 7pm is cheaper than during tea time!

Our TOP 3 small changes to save annually on your energy

- Use a bowl in the sink to reduce water waste, and rinse dishes with cold water NOT hot.
- Spend 1 minute less in the shower each day and save on average £10 each year on your energy bill, and around £17 on your water (if you're on a water meter).
- Switch devices such as games consoles, TVs and phone chargers off rather than leaving them on standby, saving £35 a year.

Supporting families with childcare costs

ATTENTION ALL PARENTS OF 3 AND 4 YEAR OLDS

All 3 and 4 year olds are entitled to 15 hours free childcare from the term **after** their 3rd birthday.

Children of Working Parents may be entitled to 30 hours childcare per week.

To find out if you qualify and apply, go on-line to: <u>www.childcarechoices.gov.uk</u> (You can also apply for Tax Free Childcare on the same link)

NOTE: PARENTS NEED TO APPLY FOR THEIR 30 HOUR ELIGIBILITY CODE <u>THE TERM BEFORE</u> THEY WANT TO CLAIM 30 HOURS

To ensure you can claim 30 hours free childcare during the autumn term, HMRC are encouraging parents **to apply before the end of August** <u>at the latest</u>, as any applications received after 31st August 2022 will **not be** eligible to claim the additional hours in the autumn term

To be eligible for 30 hours from September 2022, both parts of the criteria below must be met:

The child must be 3 or 4 years old before **31st August 2022**; and Working parents must have applied and been issued with an eligibility code with a start date **before 31st August 2022**

(REMINDER – Parents who have already applied and are eligible for 30 hours are reminded that they MUST re-confirm eligibility every 3 months, by logging into their Government Gateway account)
